## From The Finance Team

Our goals as a Finance Team are to receive input from our pastors, lay leaders, ministry teams and church members, regarding church ministry needs and opportunities, and then compile this in a way that is responsible, meets needs and honors God. Throughout the budget year we guide overall expenditures within the approved budget and report back to the congregation at Quarterly Business Meetings.

We meet the third Tuesday of each month to review the previous month's financials and make decisions regarding upcoming projected expenditures. Our meetings are open and we encourage your input and involvement throughout the year. We welcome your insights and inquiries about new ministries you would like us to consider.

## Planning Ahead

Your Finance Team will continue our previously established escrow plan for facility and equipment upgrades, including but not limited to:

**Climate Control:** Heating and air conditioning upgrades and replacements as existing equipment ages out or becomes uneconomical to repair.

**Street Signage:** Since our existing electronic sign is both outdated and failing, we are re-purposing previously donated funds for streaming services to the south campus to replace the old sign with a multi-media friendly color billboard to enhance our community outreach potential.

**Printing/Copying:** Our equipment lease will expire in early 2019. Leasing has not proven to be a good alternative for FBS, and our goal is to accumulate sufficient funds to purchase our own equipment and negotiate a favorable long term maintenance contract.

**Risk Management:** As the current meteorological environment reminds us, it is well that we be adequately insured for damage to our buildings and contents. Unfortunately, hurricane deductibles are quite high, often running into six figures. We hope to build a fund to deal with such an eventuality.

# Message From Our Finance Chairman

The 2017-2018 budget is a testament to God's continued grace to provide for our church and to further His ministry. Our ministry leaders and staff continue to provide the ministries and missions tasked for us while being prudent and responsible with spending.

This proposed budget of \$1,525,556 equates to an average weekly giving of \$29,338 and is a decrease of 4.93% over last year's budget.



As we see God's Word unfolding before our eyes and hearts... natural disasters, cultural ridicule, persecution of the faithful, and governments who chafe at the reality that there is a God, OUR GOD, who is greater than all of man's conceits: A God who has committed US to tell them of a love and hope that is there simply for the asking (2 Chr 7:14). ### For FBS, "sacrifice" has two immediate perspectives:
