REGISTRATION

- Registration begins January 1, 2019.
- Cost: \$99
- Early Bird Discount: \$89 if <u>Registered AND Paid</u> in full by midnight, Wednesday, January 30 (includes t-shirt)
 A T-Shirt is not guaranteed if full DNOW payment is made after January 30!
- Deadline to Register AND Pay On-Line is Sunday, February 10

MEDICAL RELEASE FORM

- Required an UP TO DATE, notarized Medical Release Form must be on file to participate
- Download and Print from the bottom of the DNOW webpage or pick up a copy at the South Campus Welcome Desk or church office
- A notary is available in the church office and will notarize your form for free. Please stop by the office anytime Monday - Thursday, 8:30 - 5 and Friday, 8:30-12:00.

LODGING

- There are 2 large dormitories at Camp Ithiel 1 for the guys and 1 for the girls
- Small group leaders will be staying with the students.
- Please clearly label all your student's belongings and remind your students that it is unacceptable to touch or go through other's belongings. Students are no allowed to lay on a bed that is not their own.
- We recommend a bag with a lock due to jokesters

TRANSPORTATION

- Parents will be responsible for transportation to Camp Ithiel on Friday. Drop off is 6:00pm Friday Night.
- Students will be driven by Sweetwater adults to worship on Sunday morning. <u>Pick up on the South Campus</u> is immediately following worship Sunday afternoon.
- Each driver will be 25 yrs old or older & will have a license review by our insurance company provided by the church.

MEALS / SNACKS

4 Meals - Provided by Camp Ithiel

- Please eat dinner prior to arrival at Camp Ithiel on Friday
- Saturday (all 3 meals) and Sunday morning breakfast
- Students are **NOT** permitted to keep food or drinks in their cabins.

2 Evening Snacks – Provided by Student Ministries

- Friday & Saturday nights after worship
- If your student wishes to bring personal snacks, they will turn in their snacks upon arrival to the camp and these snacks will be available during meal and snack times only. All snacks are stored in the kitchen.
- If your student has any <u>food or medication allergies</u>, please list these on the Registration Form and their Medical Release form in case of emergency reaction, leadership will know the possible cause. Your student is responsible for knowing what he or she can/cannot eat!

WEDNESDAY BEFORE DNOW, FEB 13:

- There is **NO** mandatory parent meeting this year! All pertinent information will be communicated via <u>PARENT EMAIL</u>!!
- This night is the Last opportunity to turn in NOTARIZED Medical Release Forms AND/OR fill out a Medical Card, Time Out Card or Vehicle Permission Card.

THINGS WE HAVE AN UNDERSTANDING ABOUT - AKA "THE RULES":

- <u>Cell phones are a privilege, not a necessity!</u> Because this is a weekend designed for discipleship and small group fellowship, cell phones will be allowed but only during free times & BIG Rec! Students should bring a Bible to use during Bible study and Worship.
 <u>This means no one can use their phone for their Bible!</u> IF there is a problem with a student regarding their cell phones, parents will need to let Pastor Ryan know.
- Everyone is expected to attend all events and meals and be on time. This means that everyone should be doing what everyone else is doing. In the event of illness, an adult leader may give permission for a student to be in a place other than with the whole group.
- LIGHTS OUT means that all students should be quiet and in bed with phones off.
- No P.D.A (public or private displays of affection).
- Students are not permitted in a cabin or on the porch that is not their own.
- Students should not mess with or go through other people's personal belongings or lie on a bed that is not your own.
- Student's name should be clearly visible on all luggage. We recommend a lock for their bag in case of a jokester.
- DRESS appropriately. If there are any questions concerning clothing, don't even bring it. (For example: no spaghetti straps, tight tank top shirts guys or girls, short skirts, inappropriate slogans, etc.) Students must be fully covered at all times, except in the shower.
- No tobacco, vapes, e-cigerates, drugs, alcohol, weapons or fireworks. THIS IS NON- NEGOTIABLE and will result in your immediate dismissal from the event.
- All Prescription drugs must be in their original container and your student's name must be on the outside of the container/bottle. Please fill out the red Medical Info. card and return to Lisa Waller.
- Personal Transportation requests MUST be approved ahead of time by Pastor Ryan and an orange Car Permission slip signed by a parent/guardian and returned to Lisa Waller. No student is allowed to leave in a vehicle unless authorized by Pastor Ryan, even if they drove their own vehicle.
- If your student needs to leave for a period of time for any reason, please fill out a blue Time Out card and return to Lisa Waller.
- Students are not permitted to keep food or drinks in their cabins. Student will turn in their snacks upon arrival to Camp and these snacks will be available during meal and snack times only. All snacks are stored in the kitchen.
- Students are expected to honor the camp by cleaning up trash.
- Anyone who cannot abide by the guidelines for this event <u>may be sent home</u>. This includes not only blatant offenses, but also
 activity that consistently distracts from what we are asking God to do in other's lives as well.
