Children's Music Day Camp SuperSummerSinginFunner (SSSF) FAQ's

- What is SuperSummerSinginFunner (SSSF)? Our Annual Children's Music Day Camp where children enjoy a week of musical rehearsals, recreation, skating, talent show, adventure water day, and a trip to Fun Spot. The week culminates with a performance of a musical on Sunday evening.
- When is SuperSummerSinginFunner (SSSF)? Monday, July 22 Sunday, July 28, 2019 No Saturday event
- ♦ Who can be in SSSF? All children who have completed Kindergarten–5th grade, signup your friends!
- What is the cost of SSSF and rate deadlines?
 - o FBS Membership Rate April 1 June 14; \$100 per child if paid in full by June 14
 - Early Bird Rate April 1 June 14; \$120 for 1st child, \$115 for additional siblings if paid in full by June 14
 - o Regular Rate June 15; \$130 for 1st child, \$125 for additional siblings paid in full by July 5
 - Late Registration after July 5; \$155, if space is available
- When are the auditions? Every child can be a part of the SSSF choir, however we hold auditions on Tuesday, June 11 from 12:30-1:30 OR 6:00-7:00pm for children interested in a specific part. Sign-up for auditions at https://doodle.com/poll/76kqmt86gxrbp7s8
- What is musical this year? Faith News A Bible Stories Breaking News Musical for Kids
- ♦ What are the times for the camp? Camp begins daily at 9:00am, drop off between 8:45-9am. Afternoon activities effect the pickup times; Monday Wednesday 4pm, Thursday 5:30pm, Friday 2:00pm.
- How do I register my children?
 - Online Registration Form submitted www.fbsweetwater/sssf
 - Registration & Extended Care Payment Options:
 - Cash or check (payable to First Baptist Sweetwater)
 - Debit or credit card <u>www.fbsweetwater.org</u> at online giving button. You can make a guest transaction and place it under, Donate - Contribution - "SSSF Music Camp".
 - You may register and make payments, as long as amount is paid in full by the Rate Deadline listed above.

- When is the performance?
 - o Main Performance: Sunday, July 28, at 6pm in the worship center. Invite friends!
 - Dress Rehearsal: Friday, July 26 during camp, Children, please be sure to attend.

♦ Costumes:

- Drama cast need to wear a costume. Type and style of costume depends upon the character.
- Choir will wear long jean pants and the SSSF T-shirt and sneakers or closed toed shoes.
- There will be <u>NO SATURDAY</u> activities.
- We will provide special music for worship: Sunday, July 28, 10:00-noon, meet in the Adult Choir Room at 10:10.
- ♦ When you register your child, you are giving First Baptist Sweetwater these rights:
 - Photos and/or a video may be taken of your student and used in future publicity of FBSweetwater events.
 - o Transportation of your child to off-site events via chartered bus or personal vehicles.
 - In the case of an emergency, we will seek whatever medical attention is deemed necessary.
- What about illness? Children who are ill and running a fever need to stay at home. We are sorry we cannot offer any guarantees of refunds.
- What is the camp dress code? We strive for modesty at SSSF and appreciate your support in this matter.
 - Modest shorts, capris or crop pants, or jeans
 - Loose fitting, short sleeved shirts that come well below the waist
 - o Possible needs a sweater or light weight jacket for air-conditioned rooms

What about drop off and pickup?

- Drop-off behind Building C. (Follow the signs to the drop off point) between 8:45 and 9:00 am.
- At Drop-off we have a chaperoned and secure roped off area in which your child will remain until
 9:00 am. Children must remain in drop off area and not wander around on the property.
- Pick-up Security Car Line Identification Tag with child's names PRINTED CLEARLY and displayed in front windshield.
- Pick-up Routine -- PLEASE BE ON TIME
 - North Campus -- behind Building C on Monday, Thursday, and Friday
 - South Campus On Tuesday & Wednesday, enter driveway on the East side and drive behind building to pick up near the playground on the west side of the building

Parent Volunteer Service Opportunities:

Many hands make heavy work light. We ask each family to be involved in some area of service during the week. We do this for our Lord and our precious children and thank you for your service! Please see below some of the opportunities and sign-up online to help as you register your child.

- Administrative Assistant Helps with various SSSF office work on TUESDAY, July 16, from 6:00pm. 8:00pm. Work includes laminating and organizing t-shirt distribution. (Need 6-8 parents)
- Small Group Leader Age-group teacher during hours of 8:30 am-12:00 pm. Helps youth plan and lead a 30 minute, age-appropriate, recreational activity each day (groups are divided by grades and size ranges from 12-18 children with 3 to 4 other adult and youth small group leaders). Sits with children and assists them in staying focused during large group time while musical rehearsal is in session. Small group workers are expected to stay with their group for each afternoon activity, and the Sunday evening prep time prior to the performance.
- Greeter Adults who can watch children at drop off area and make sure they are safe. Safety is key. We need MORNING GREETERS each day from 8:15 9:15am. You will have a few youth and an adult staff member to assist you. (SSSF staff meets @ 8:30am for prayer.)
- Parent drivers for Monday and Thursday's activities. For insurance purposes we will need the following
 information from you: Full name as it is written on your driver's license, your complete date of birth, and a
 copy of your vehicle insurance card.
 - Monday's Activity to and from Semoran Skateway. Meet at the south campus by 12:15 to load children, pick children up at the skating rink at 3:00 and return to the north campus at 3:45pm. If you would like to skate the cost is \$5.00
 - Thursday's Activity to and from Fun Spot on International Drive. Meet at the north campus at 11:00 to load children. Pick up at Fun Spot at 4:15pm and return to the north campus at 5:15. If you would like to stay at Fun Spot, it is free to walk around, but if you would like a wristband to ride with your child the cost is \$35, which includes pizza lunch and soda. I must know ahead of time if you would like to purchase a wristband.
- o Tuesday Activity Coordinator (Talent Day) Decorate stage area; call children for information if needed.
- Wacky Wednesday Adventure Day Coordinator and Workers (8 people) Coordinator makes sure workers are informed and at each station.
- Stage Assistant Assists drama director in any way needed in rehearsals, off stage or in the sound booth.
- Prop Director Adult with an imagination who can secure props for musical at "low or no cost".
- Costume Director Adult who makes or secures proper costumes for special characters as needed.
- Make-up Assistants Adults who will apply stage makeup for Friday dress rehearsal and Sunday presentation.
