■ THE GOAL

The goal of our S2M Summer Mission Trip is to create an opportunity for Sweetwater Students (6th-12th grade) grow as followers of Jesus by serving others in a unique setting, as part of a team, guided by committed Christ-followers, who will encourage them to seek God in focused way and discover life-changing lessons, while creating an environment that fosters deeper relationships, aha moments, a selfless attitude, and fun!

■ OUR PARTNERSHIP

Team Effort is an established organization, based in Jacksonville, FL, that specializes in student mission trips all over the country. They provide a quality program that includes:

Our team is responsible for Free Day activities on Thursday & Friday and 2 meals, in addition to travel. Travel is the largest cost associated with this trip. We are working to figure out the most cost-effective solution. Regardless of our travel plans, group fundraising is essential.

This Year's Theme is "Mountaintops" We will focus a few different mountaintop moments throughout scripture. Sunday we will be looking at Elijah when God met him in a cave through a gentle whisper. Monday's focus will be on Moses and the Covenant with God. Tuesday will be the women at the well. Wednesday's story is The Transfiguration. Thursday is Jesus with Jesus's crucifixion at the Mount of Olives and Calvary.

■ THE COST

Mission trips are never cheap. Our **cost** per student is somewhere between \$700 & \$875, depending on travel solutions. We are committed to fundraising to offset the cost of this trip so that our students can participate in this life-changing experience, and a Sweetwater tradition.

Sweetwater Students who are active members of our church and student ministry, and who participate in our planned fundraisers are responsible for **\$275.00** of this cost. A **\$75** deposit is due no later than April 2nd, for those who desire to go on the trip.

We understand that the cost of this trip may seem unattainable, even at a significant discount. Here are some ways to earn funds for your trip:

- Discount Cards You may sell our printed discount cards at @\$20/card to people in your neighborhood or circle of influence.
 Cards sold to Sweetwater attendees at FB Sweetwater on Sunday mornings will go toward group fundraising efforts. Any cards sold personally, outside of Sweetwater may offset your personal costs. You are responsible for cards taken and must return the appropriate funds or unsold cards.
- Rent-A-Student The Rent-A-Student fundraiser will help offset the costs of those who participate.
- Support Letters we will provide a form letter that you may use to request financial support from family members and invested adults.
- Work Days If you received a work-day credit, we have applied \$30 per work-day to your account.
