

A Note from Pastor Buddy

Hello Sweetwater Family!

From time to time people outside our Sweetwater Family will ask "How are things at the church?" or "Is your church growing?". Good questions, but the real question is, "How do you measure success in God's economy?".

Too often we automatically apply the world's definitions of success to God's Kingdom. I mentioned in a sermon recently that the Church had largely lost the original intent to Jesus' command to "go and make disciples", instead choosing to "go and make church members". We falsely believe that being a church member and being a disciple are one and the same. They are not, nor have they ever been. In 1 John 2:19, the beloved disciple refers to church members "who went out from us, but they were not really of us." It was probably 40 years ago when Billy Graham said that he believed only about 20% of people in churches were saved.

No, in God's economy it's all about making disciples, not putting people in seats. Here, a small church with 50 real disciples is more successful than a larger church, with bigger buildings and a larger budget, that only has about 10 real disciples. And while its true that such a judgement is solely left to the Lord, the Lord did say that "by their fruits you will know them".

Still, one could argue that we have to get them in the seats first before they can be discipled. And there is truth to that. So, here at Sweetwater, ever since my first day, there has been great concern to rebuild the young adult and children's ministries. There was a time when we only had 1 child in the toddler room and the young adults could have met in a phone booth. Neither of those things are true anymore. The last two weeks we have had 14 in the toddler's room, and we have 3 different young adult groups that are generally divided by age. The last two years we have been ordaining young adult men to serve as deacons. Our young adults are growing in faith and the children's building is getting louder!

Want to see how successful we're being? Volunteer in the toddler room! And I'm serious! We have more little ones than we are set up to handle. We need help there! Even if you could give one Sunday every six weeks, that would be a big help.

And be praying for Dan White and our young adult ministry and for our precious volunteers who are currently leading our children's ministry. And always be in prayer for your church.


